


# DefendX Software Control-QFS Release Notes

# I. Upgrading and Backwards Compatibility

Upgrading should be compatible from any previous version of QFS. All components should be upgraded to the same version family.

## **II.** File Servers Supported

#### QFS 8.6 supports the following server types:

- 1. Microsoft Windows
  - Includes support for Windows Cluster
- 2. NetApp
  - 7-Mode
  - C-Mode
- 3. EMC
  - VNX
  - Isilon
- 4. Hitachi HNAS
- 5. Other NAS Servers

## **III.** Things to Note

- QFS has mixed 32 and 64 bit components and installs to Program Files (x86) by default. The admin is still 32-bit.
- The 64-bit services now use registry entries in HKLM\Software\NTPSoftware and not the wow6432node.
- Upgrades from previous versions are supported.
- Only 64bit operating systems are supported (2008R2 and up).



### IV. What's New in QFS v8.6

- Increased the timeout value to 90 seconds when attempting to stop the services during an upgrade to help replace files correctly.
- 64-bit services the qfs service and connector services are now 64-bit components.

## V. Bug Fixes in QFS v8.6

- Bug fix: Fixed a system crash when a file quota policy is created and a user writes to the folder managed by the policy
- Bug fix: Fixed an issue with the QFS service not receiving updates from EASE when policies are created and or changed.
- Bug fix: NAS Proxy upgrade error.
- Bug fix: The qotsmtp and qotsnmp dlls now have version information included in them so that they upgrade correctly.
- Bug fix: Blue screen in the filter when checking for a user exemption when the user sid was NULL.
- Bug fix: Changed the scanning engine to use .snapshot instead of ~snapshot for Isilon directories.
- Bug fix: Fixed an access violation that could occur in a low memory situation when CNaPathname::Allocate would fail.
- Bug fix: French characters not showing up in plain text emails correctly
- Bug fix: Email variable %F not showing correctly for FMP activate once at end.
